Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

I hope that you are well.

If your son is diagnosed with Covid-19 over the coming weeks can you please inform the school, <u>admin@kings.lincs.sch.uk</u>, so that we have a record of this for when we start lateral flow testing on their return.

Your son should be following his normal timetable even if he has not received an invitation to the lesson. We are receiving some reports of students not having microphones restricting them from participating in lessons. Simple USB microphones can be purchased online for less than £3, including delivery.

Changes to all students' usernames

As part of our continued improvement in our Information Technology infrastructure we are having to change all student usernames. Passwords will not change. Over the coming weeks students will receive an individualised email informing them that their username is changing.

It will be changed from the format forename.familyname to 19.f.familyname. Please can students watch out for the email confirming that the change is in process. [The 19. represents the year the year group joined the school, Y8 - 19; Y9 - 18, Y10 - 17; Y11 - 16; Y12 - 15 and Y13 - 14].

We anticipate making this change on Thursday 28 January for Year 8, although this does rely on Microsoft's availability. This process is already complete for Year 7 and will continue with other years over the coming weeks.

Vulnerable Children and Critical Workers

The provision in school will continue for the Vulnerable Children and Critical Workers' group.

Only one parent needs to be a Critical Worker to access this facility. Please state the days required over the next two-week period. The school will be open from 08:30 until 15:45 for this small group of students.

Free School Meals

All Free School Meals families will be provided with vouchers for £15 per week during the period 25 January to 12 February 2021 through the EdenRed National Voucher Scheme. The February half term break will be funded and a voucher will be provided with details nearer the time. Student 1:1 meetings are being scheduled for the week beginning 8 February and will be held on Teams. Students are only required to fill in the King's School application form and save their populated document in their student locker at this stage.

Year 13 Mock Examinations

The Year 13 mock exams are calendared to be starting on Monday 8 February. The enforced closure of the school has required us to modify our plans and our hope is to be able to run the mocks in the first two weeks after half term (22 February-5 March). We will continue to review the national guidance and will keep you informed if any alterations are required due to further school closures.
