The school's entrance examination is **paper-based** 11+ testing (Verbal Reasoning and Non-Verbal Reasoning and Spatial Awareness) for in-year Year 7 entry and an **online** CAT with 3 sections: Verbal Reasoning, Non-Verbal Reasoning & Spatial Ability, and Quantitative Reasoning for in-year Year 8-11. The qualifying score for consideration for entry to King's is 220 for 11+ testing and a mean score of 114 or above for a CAT.
