Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of your son's History A-Level studies he will be completing one piece of coursework on the causes of the English Civil War. This piece of coursework will be approximately 3000-3500 words and counts for 20% of the History A-Level. The task examines the causes of the English Civil War over a period of one hundred years. The formal teaching of this topic took place in the last term of Year 12 and your son is now starting the task of planning and drafting the essay in lessons. Fifteen hours of lesson time at the start of this term have been allocated to enable your son to plan and begin drafting this essay.
