CAREERS TALK – APPRENTICESHIPS

On Tuesday 11 February we have organised a talk on Apprenticeships between 4.15pm and 4.45pm. All students and their parents are welcome to attend and the event will take place in the Old School.

The talk will be delivered by the Apprenticeship Support & Knowledge for Schools (ASK) Project. This project is funded by the National Apprenticeship Service, part of the Department for Education. The aim of the organisation is to work with schools and other educational establishments across England to increase awareness of apprenticeships. This presentation will explore the different levels of apprenticeship and will cover all routes up to and including degree level apprenticeships.

Numbers will be limited and we ask students and parents to sign up in advance and no later than Monday 10 February.
