Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

I hope that you are all well and have had an opportunity to enjoy the good weather that we are currently having.

You are probably aware that the long-awaited government guidance on the reopening of Secondary Schools was made available to schools on Bank Holiday Monday. The release includes that secondary schools are to open for 'face to face' meetings with students no earlier than 15 June.

The King's School will open for students in Year 10 and Year 12 in the week beginning 15 June. During the first week of opening, students should use the online booking system to arrange an individual time slot to come into school, meet with a teacher and have a tour of the school to prepare them for observing the social distancing requirements and the new one-way systems that are in place. Unaccompanied students, or students accompanied by one parent or carer, will have the opportunity to book the consultation and tour with a teacher. We advise that when making this booking the student selects a teacher whom they are familiar with.

There will be a follow up letter to this nearer the time with the booking details. Students will not be expected to wear school uniform. The week of 15 June is our first phase in reopening the school. Provided the first phase is successful and we are confident that social distancing will be observed we will move to a second phase. In the second phase students will be invited to school for a day a week. We anticipate that in the second phase there will be classes of eight students. We will release more detail around the later phases next week.
